### JOB DESCRIPTION

**KNOWLEDGE:** A B.S. degree in management information systems or equivalent and at least seven years experience required. Prior upper-level management experience preferred. Need to understand various operating systems on servers such as: Linux, Windows, and Solaris. Know Citrix and VMWare virtual environments. Need to have knowledge of clustering. Know database systems such as PostgreSQL, MySQL, Oracle, and Sequel Server. Need to have knowledge of IT tools for communication, collaboration, and productivity. Provide for nightly server data backup and security of company information. Communicate clear, concise information to affected groups and department leaders of any IT issues. Conduct performance and wage reviews of subordinate personnel. Enforce company policies and procedures to protect against malware, detect and shield attempts at unauthorized computer access, and guard the integrity of company data bases and computer systems.
