**GENERAL FUNCTION:** Responsible for technical support and marketing efforts, as supervised by market manager, directed toward environmental-related customers, especially those with systems related to road weather. This involves educating customers in the use of Campbell Scientific dataloggers and peripherals for related applications, and assisting them, when necessary, in locating and fixing problems related to Campbell Scientific products. It also requires maintaining or obtaining familiarity with respective markets, recognizing the needs of customers within these markets, and proposing changes to or the development of products to maintain or improve Campbell Scientific's competitiveness.

**KNOWLEDGE & SKILL:** Position requires, at a minimum, a BS degree or equivalent in a meteorology- or civil-engineering-related field. Knowledge of general electronics and the application of physics to solve measurement problems is essential. Knowledge or familiarity with data communication protocols, specifically related to the RWIS industry and/or experience with road beds and associated construction materials is beneficial.
