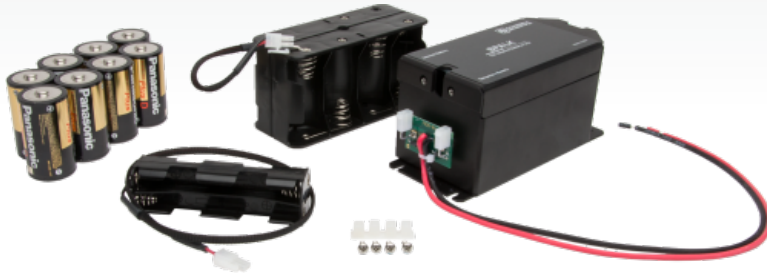










# Batteries

## Rechargeable batteries and alkaline battery packs



When you are using a regulator that does not include a battery, select a battery with the best size for your station's needs. You can also purchase replacement batteries for older batteries that were included with your regulator. Alkaline battery packs are also available for use in short-term applications or in applications where it is feasible to periodically replace the batteries.
