The whom it may concern,

E+E understands "shelf-lifetime" as the period of time when a new product kept on stock in the original packaging will remain within specs.

The shelf-lifetime has nothing to do with the validity of a factory calibration certificate, which states the product performance when leaving the E+E manufacturing site and does not carry a due date (by definition "certificate").

E+E air velocity sensors: shelf-lifetime two years

E+E temperature sensors: shelf-lifetime two years

E+E humidity sensors: shelf-lifetime one year depending on the environment (see also
